

As the 2022/23 VFW year works to a close it looks like we have become an All-State/All-American Post for the 3rd time in three years. We have successfully completed all programs and more. Thanks to your efforts, and Jr. Vice Cmdr. Tony Reyes's program administration, we have achieved number two status in VFW program points in our VFW division.

Regarding the always formidable task of recruitment, VFW Post 7721 has achieved 102% of our VFW assigned goal under the direction of Sr. Vice Cmdr. Jack Fulmer and Recruitment Chair Dick Miller. We have never exceeded goal this early in the VFW year before. Our VFW assigned goal was 605 members. In order to become All-American we needed 100% plus one member. In order to become All-State we needed 100% plus one percent. For our goal: Six new members equals approximately one percent. Thank you to everyone actively participating in recruitment. Our VFW Post would not have achieved such success without your efforts.

Thank you for all you do everyday for your VFW Post.



Our membership rolls continue to increase as we near the end of March 2023. Our overall objective continues to be to grow our member numbers, build a stronger Post, and make a larger impact within our local community. Currently, for the month of March, we have grown to having 488 Life Members, 21 new members, 3 member reinstatements, and 107 continuous annual members. This gives us a total of 619 members. This means that we have qualified on the membership portion of the VFW Florida State grading system for both All State and All American status. This is a major accomplishment for our Post as we are the first Post in our District 13 to obtain this dual recognition status. Included in our new membership rolls for March 2023 is a 4-Star US Navy Admiral, Jerry Johnson. While on active duty, he served as the Assistant Chief of Naval Operations and was a Navy jet pilot who was a member of the elite honorary Tailhook Society. This marks our second 4-Star Flag Officer post member – US Army General Fred Franks, Commander of the Coalition forces in the Operation Freedom of Kuwait campaign, being the second.

We need to continually strive to expand our membership base. Many of our potential members are our neighbors and friends. Most are easily recognizable with their hats and shirts reflecting their military affiliation. Reach out to them and extend an invitation to join our Post. Always carry a blank membership form or two with you. You might be pleasantly surprised because you are the only person who ever asked them to join. Based upon our 2023 success with membership, there is no reason we can't expand our membership base to an even higher level.

The Post Honor Guard team continued to be actively engaged in performing military and civic ceremonies. During March, we performed 5 ceremonies. I will mention two of the more prominent. A memorial service was held for a WWII US Army Air Corps 1st Lieutenant, Joseph Innes. This ceremony was held at The Strand Golf and Country Club. A second service in which the Honor Guard participated was an official flag raising ceremony at the Moorings Park Grande Lakes community. The raising of the flag was performed on the community's recently erected flag pole. The Honor Guard performed 2 Commemorative Readings during the month. One was held on 24 MAR to commemorate the start of the Kosovo Campaign in 1999. The second reading was held on 31 MAR to commemorate the end of Operation Restore Hope in Somalia in 1995.

We continued to acknowledge deceased veterans in the state of Florida by making an appropriate entry into their online Memorial Guestbooks. During March, we posted 6 entries.

No Commemorative Tribute Readings are scheduled for April, but the Honor Guard continues to conduct Memorials and Ceremonies throughout the County.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,






