PLEASE, HAVE ALL ENTRIES IN FOR THE NEWSLETTER BY THE 25TH OF EVERY As we enter into the new year you are invited to participate in the campaign to ensure Collier County obtains the next State of Florida VA Nursing Home. The plan is to build the new nursing home on the old Golden Gate Golf Course. Collier County paid \$29 million for the old golf course property and put another \$30 million into escrow to entice the State of Florida to build the new nursing home here. However, the construction will not start for another four or five years. A lot can happen in that time and the final agreement is not guaranteed. Marion County is campaigning vigorously to have the next Florida State VA Nursing Home built on property already set aside in Ocala.

Members of the Marion County community are campaigning vigorously for the new nursing home to be built in Ocala. We need to contact Governor DeSantis, our State Senator, Senate President Kathleen Passidomo, Florida State Legislator Bob Rommel and our County Commissioners. None of these individuals have expressed absolute support for the VA Nursing Home in Collier County. We need to clearly communicate to them, repeatedly, our desire to have the next VA Nursing Home constructed here in Collier County. At this time, it is in no way guaranteed that Collier County will have the next State of Florida VA Nursing Home. Be prepared to fight for it. Actively participate in the fight.

VFW Post membership is encouraged to rationalize our VFW Post scholarship programs over the next year. We currently donate a large amount of scholarship funds to non-VFW scholarship programs and much smaller amounts to VFW Scholarship programs. We also experienced a disjointed effort with JROTC scholarships this year caused by leadership changes in the Collier County Public Schools system and the effects of our separation from the high school JROTC programs created by COVID – 19 when outside organizations could not readily participate in school programs. Work with me for a coherent VFW Post Scholarship program.


I would appreciate asking the new leadership team to approve of a program that would create a packet we could present to new members. The packet should contain all the Post and Auxiliary elected positions as well as appointed positions. We tried to implement a "New Member Packet' program. Several people offered to help; but there were never any tangible results. We would like to ask you to join us with input from as many members as possible to present a coherent packet to the incoming leadership for their approval. Our input will take a load off the shoulders of our new leadership team and allow them to concentrate on important VFW Post matters. Organizations across the country have attacked Law Enforcement. Join me this year in expressing unwavering support for our brothers and sisters in Law Enforcement as well as other public servants; such as, Firefighters, EMTs, and school teachers.

Of special mention was a Veterans Appreciation Day Ceremony held at Avow Hospice. The Color Guard opened the event with the presentation of our Nation's Colors followed by a flag folding ceremony. The folded flag was presented to a veteran chosen by the Avow management staff. Major Randy Cash, our Post Quartermaster, was the guest speaker. Also of significance was our selection as the Color Guard to open the two Memorial Day performances of the Patriotic Pops concert conducted by the Artis symphony and chorus (Artis is the old Naples Philharmonic).

We continued to acknowledge deceased veterans in the state of Florida by making an appropriate entry into their online Memorial Guestbooks. During May, we posted 9 entries.






