Our Post hosted the quarterly District 13 Post and Auxiliary meeting on 19 AUG 2023. The total individuals in attendance was approximately 50. After the joint meeting session concluded, several attendees gathered outside the back auditorium for a Flag Retirement Ceremony. A ceremonial flag was retired accompanied by a reading of the flag retirement proclamation expressing the symbolism of this sacred ceremony. Many of the District Post's brought with them American flags to be retired. Two Scouts from our Post Scout Troop 25 retired several flags. The remainder of the flags brought to the District meeting were stored in our external Connex storage container. They will subsequently be given to a local Naples Fire Station that officially retires American flags. The conclusion of the District meeting consisted of a School of Instruction conducted by our Sr. Vice Commander. He spoke on the topics of Patriots Pen and the Voice of Democracy.

A special birthday party was held this past month for Captain Wayne Smith, U.S. Air Force Vietnam veteran. Captain Smith enjoyed the celebration of his 80th birthday. The event was attended by many of Wayne's adoring friends and was a huge success.

The Post leadership team attended a Post Service Officer training course and a School of Instruction focused on numerous Post related administrative topics. The 2 day training session was held in Orlando during the period 18-19 AUG 2023.

Three memorial services were conducted this month. The major service was held in honor of Post member, Sam Heath. Sam was a veteran of the Korean War and served in the U.S. Air Force. Sam was a very dedicated member of the Post who gave freely of his time and financial support. The folded American Flag was presented to his wife, Joyce, at the conclusion of the ceremony. A second memorial service was held at the Fuller Funeral Home for Thomas Demes, a U. S. Army Vietnam veteran. The third ceremony was held for Staff Sergeant William Carey at the Palm Royale Funeral Home. Sgt. Carey was also a U. S. Army decorated Vietnam veteran.

The Post was represented at the America's 13 Tribute ceremony held in Punta Gorda 26 AUG 2023. This ceremony honored the 13 U. S. soldiers killed while U. S. troops were departing the airport in Kabul, Afghanistan. This event was held exactly two years after the withdrawal from Afghanistan.

Planning continues for several local Veterans Day ceremonies. The locations include Siena Lakes Retirement Community, Falling Waters community, the Women's Republican Club of Naples, Quail West Country Club, and the Vanderbilt Country Club. These ceremonies will be held primarily on 10 and 11 NOV 2023 and will mark the peak season of the Post Honor Guard activities.

The 1st Annual dues notice went out on July 1st. Three of those annual members have converted to life! There are presently 301 paid members. We are at 88.27% paid for the 2023-2024 membership year. The milestone of reaching 90% by September 1st is within our reach!

Our auxiliary paid our yearly obligations, health and happiness dues, and our district dues in July. The office of the President and Treasurer have been bonded. The 990N E-Card was filed on July 1st with the IRS.

Thank you to the recruiters for the new member sign ups. Keep up the great work. All applications that are turned in should have proof of eligibility and the dues required. Make sure the applicant has entered their date of birth, has signed the membership application and correctly writes down their relationship to the eligible veteran. Their relationship must be: Husband/Wife/ Sons/ Daughters/ Widower/Widow/ Father/Mother/ Brothers/Sisters/ Grandfathers/Grandmothers/ Grandsons/Granddaughters. *Stepand adopted parents, children, siblings (and half-siblings), grandparents and grandchildren are considered the same as biological parents, children, siblings, grandparents and grandchildren and may join the VFW Auxiliary under their VFW-eligible veteran.* The eligible veteran must have foreign and/or sea service and served in a foreign war or conflict or and/or collected hazardous duty pay. Most veterans serving only stateside do not qualify.

If the eligible veteran is a member of #7721, that member may come in as an affiliated member and does not have to provide proof of eligibility. Life member transfers do not have to show proof of eligibility. If you need help with membership, please call or email me.
